VIVE LE CINEMA AT OCEAN TERMINAL!

The Auld Alliance will be rekindled this week as the French Film Festival descends upon Ocean Terminal Shopping Centre, Leith.

From this Thursday (26th) until Sunday (29th) the centre will be transformed as it takes on an overall French theme.

As part of this year's annual event, four French films (OSS 117: Le Caire - Nid d'espions, Quatre Etoiles, Camping and Le Temps des Porte-Plumes) will be screened at Vue Cinema, and actress Berenice Bejo and director Michel Hazanavicius will be present at the screening of OSS 117: Le Caire - Nid d'espions on Thursday April 26.

Throughout Saturday and Sunday, shoppers will be able to sample French wine, cheese, bread and pastries from Baxters, compete in a Petanque (French Boules) competition, watch French impressionists entertain the crowds and listen to French music.

Edinburgh based French artist, Martine Pugh, will also be exhibiting at the centre. Using textiles and ephemeral materials, Martine's installations evoke the relationship between Scotland and France.
