FUERZABRUTA

One of the world's largest touring venues has arrived at Leith's Ocean Terminal in preparation for the Edinburgh Fringe Festival.

Fuerzabruta, the cult smash hit show which has toured the world and been enjoyed by audiences in Buenos Aires, Lisbon, London and Bogotá, will take place in an enormous, state of the art black tent situated opposite the shopping centre for a five week period. It will run from Saturday August 4 to Saturday September 1.

It is an all-standing rave of a show. A powerful music score, strobe lighting, lots of water, scenes of a poetic, violent and beautiful nature combine with a whole lot of mess.

A small army of crew, cast and production staff have been busy preparing the tent, which stands 24 meters tall, has footprint the size of a football pitch and a capacity of 1200 people, since Tuesday July 17, and now stands proudly in Ocean Terminal.

Fuerzabruta is the first time a show of its scale has taken place at the Waterfront in Leith during the Fringe Festival, and demonstrates Leith's suitability for such a major event.

Commenting, Fay Jameson, marketing manager of Ocean Terminal, said, "I am delighted that one of the Fringe Festival's biggest shows will be taking place down at Ocean Terminal, highlighting the Waterfront as an important venue in this year's programme of events. The eclectic nature of Fuerzabruta matches the Leith setting perfectly and we are looking forward to welcoming tourists and locals alike to the Waterfront."
